**Morning Speakers: Are you Ready? Evacuations, Preparedness and ICS [0800-1200]**

Terri Suggett – Placer County Sheriff's Office/IXII Group & Sheila Herron

Terri and Sheila brought up excellent ideas and tips that can really help prepare us in the event of a worse case scenario that our agency has never experienced but may vary likely at some point. Keys to businesses or immediate responders? What happens if your Comm Center must evacuate? What do you take? How long do you give your employees? Do they have emergency bags? Where will you go to redeploy and how? Etc.. These
